AWESOME DREAMER chased the winner along the inside into the stretch but couldn't get to that rival while clearly second best. PAINT ME RED allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch and had no late response. SILK RIDGE tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and tired. ARIEL BRIGHT chased the winner into the far turn, then faltered.
