TOPSIDE TRADER, never far back, moved closer into the stretch then closed under strong handling and ran down the leader in time. SEE MORGAN FIRST broke alertly, saved ground setting the pace and fought it out gamely to the end. BOGANGLES was unhurried early then responded well in the drive along the inside to close the gap. SABRE BABY was outrun to the stretch then finished well but was too late. UNTOPABLE raced within striking distance and lacked the needed rally. LINGOTE DE OURO (BRZ) prompted the pace and weakened in the drive. FUTURE DRAMA prompted the pace to the stretch then weakened. WHAT A WARRIOR tired. OH MY COYOTE showed little.
