KONG THE KING, well placed just off the pace inside, moved up between rivals leaving the far turn then ran down the leader leaving the furlong grounds and edged away late. DO I HAVEA WITNESS was unhurried early and edged closer leaving the backstretch, moved up outside rivals into the far turn to gain the lead then was not good enough for the winner. SILVERADO TRAIL was forwardly placed and held on well for third while no match for the top two. QUITE ACCEPTABLE lacked a solid rally. RED DIRT ROAD broke alertly to dispute the pace racing two wide for six furlongs then weakened. HIGHFLYINGEMBLEM saved ground disputing the pace then had little left for the drive.
