SWEETENING settled inside early, was eased out nearing the second turn, came four wide around the turn, loomed a threat nearing mid stretch and then was outfinished. PRIVATE WAR set a pressured pace to upper stretch, was headed and then saved the show. SIR HILLARY trailed to the drive, rallied outside and closed gamely. STEEL PIER forced the pace outside PRIVATE WAR until the drive and then faltered. HEAVEN'S HOPE raced four wide to the second turn and then stopped.
