MEXICAN TIME made the pace racing out from the rail, kicked well clear through the far turn then held safe in the drive. HOLY MOLLY stalked the pace from three wide, dropped back some through the turn and rallied back in deep stretch to gain the place. S C ALAMOATTITUDE dropped back off the early pace racing outside, fanned seven wide into the lane and closed with a good late run. CROSSING GUARD was four and five wide throughout, moved to contention going to the far turn then could not sustain the run into the stretch. ARTA B TRICKY stalked the pace from outside, awaited room briefly between rivals in the far turn and swung to the outside to fan six wide into the stretch. MISS YOU ALREADY was on the pace from three wide to late in the far turn and weakened. C O ATTACK stalked the pace from along the inside to the far turn and tired. GHAZOLENA acted up just prior to the gate's opening, dwelt and completely missed the break.
