Footnotes

TOPSIDE TRADER unhurried early, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to be up in time. PRAIRIE LITES sprinted to a long lead along the rail, made the pace to deep stretch, responded when headed by GAELIC SUNRISE in deep stretch and continued on gamely to edge that rival for the place while unable to resist the winner. GAELIC SUNRISE off slowly, chased the pace, moved to gain a brief lead in deep stretch but was outfinished. STORMY ROMAN reserved off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat in midstretch but didn't do enough late. A NICE SPLASH tracked the pace, advanced three wide into the stretch to reach the leaders but had no further response. OUTER MARKER allowed to settle, closed with a belated rally. BARGAIN BARRY unhurried while racing three wide, closed ground late without threatening. MYSTERY PROSPECT failed to menace while racing four wide. COHN BLUE (IRE) was not a factor. CUCINA NICK chased the pace along the inside into the far turn, then tired.
