CRIB KICKER settled on the inside of a rival, was urged along while three wide on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, closed fast to get the lead inside the furlong marker then drew clear under a strong hand ride. TREASURE'S OF GOLD settled on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, closed well to get the lead entering the final furlong but was quickly headed and proved no match for the winner. NEED ANET tracked the pace on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch and weakened while clear for the show. LADY LONG LEGS was rated just off the pace, lacked room while off the rail on the turn, took an awkward stride while off heels in upper stretch then lacked the needed response. MADISON COUNTYGIRL broke alertly and showed good speed, set the pace while off the rail, vied into the final furlong and tired. WHAT ATTITUDE bumped with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field and failed to threaten. ENTICING MR. G stumbled at the start, was well placed on the inside, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. FERN GLEN bumped with a rival at the start, was hard ridden near the back of the field, saved ground on the turn and was no factor.
