Footnotes

CRIB KICKER was well rated while setting the pace, responded well in the stretch and held under left hand urging. LADY TEABING (IRE) was well placed on the inside, moved off the rail nearing the quarter-pole, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was only second best. GONE CAMPIN settled near the back of the field, jostled with FREEDOM EAGLE leaving the backstretch, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty while best of the rest. FREEDOM EAGLE settled in the middle of the field, jostled with GONE CAMPIN leaving the backstretch and was in tight, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. PROUD RETURN settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. MEGGIEBIGBUCKS lagged well behind the field, saved ground on both turns, swung out entering the stretch and failed to threaten. MISS KILLIAN raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and dropped out. ROCK STEADY was washy during the warm-up, tracked the pace, came up empty on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 10 Feet)
