LADY COSMO was unhurried towards the rear of the field, swung out leaving the far turn, closed well to get the lead passing the furlong marker, edged clear under strong urging and proved best then pulled up in distress after the race and was vanned off. SOFT N' LOUD bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the inside near the back of the field, swung out entering the stretch and finished willingly for the place. WACOS CUTIE was bumped on both sides at the start, settled on the inside, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, swung out entering the stretch, closed well to make a bid near the furlong marker but was outfinished while able to get the show. PERFECT RUBY settled in the middle of the field, was urged along on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, closed into a good striking position but lacked the needed response. SULTRY MOUNTAIN settled in the middle of the field, saved ground on both turns, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed response. IN YOUR EYES broke inward and bumped with a rival, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. BRUSHABYBABY dropped well behind the field, saved ground on both turns and showed little. SWEET APPEAL contested the pace on the inside, inched clear on the far turn, was collared passing the furlong marker and weakened. BELLAGAMARA contested the pace on the outside, chased SWEET APPEAL on the far turn and tired. RAYS LAST WORD threw her head at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, went four wide on the far turn and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but was walked off.
