BOLD COMMAND stalked early firing from the turn to draw even between horses in upper stretch, dug in gamely to edge clear to wire. GAMBOLIER raced evenly firing out of the turn to draw even abreast rivals in upper stretch, taking on BOLD COMMAND late would be out gamed. PEPEE THE BARKER was sent hard pressing the pace through the turn, collared from the outside in upper stretch would weaken late. LEE'S LOOKER hesitated leaving the gate a step behind the field, angled to mid track in upper stretch gave even action under a stiff drive. MAN OF KENT raced evenly giving a mild move along the inside to upper stretch, would hang under a drive. SIR LUKE slow early played no factor. FLY NOW rushed up early would pressure the pace through the turn, was used up entering the lane. SIGNOR HUGO a step slow under early prompting tired.
