MOON SPARK raced wide and closed well. LIGHT THE CANDLES vied for command two wide and faded late. C. D. JEWEL set the pace just off the rail and weakened. ONE MORE LILLIAN stumbled leaving the gate, raced between foes while just off the pace and then tired. FULL MAKEOVER raced between foes and tired. MANSION had her heels clipped on the first turn, raced outside and tired. I'M THE ANSWER drifted out and clipped heels entering first turn. PURE VISION raced wide and tired.
