ALMAGNUS allowed to settle, circled leaving far turn, came seven wide into lane, responded to steady urging, took command while mid track and drew off in late going. ALL ABOUT US well back for half, swung six wide into stretch, finished with a solid rally to gain second spot. FUN GUN stalked leaders along inside from start, moved nearest pace mid track to loom danger, flattened out. ABIT O IRISH dueled on the outside from start, responded to gain nod at the half, went gamely to mid stretch before tiring. BACCALAUREATE trailed for three quarters, came seven wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally. ROY JACK hustled to front, dueled for lead along rail for to top stretch, gave way. SPIRIT OF FIFTYSIX stalked leaders along inside for half, failed to menace. THE COMPANY VAN was not a factor. PRINCE OF SEATTLE showed little. PATTON ON SPEED well back from start, never threatened. SANDYFORD was outrun. RUNFORTHEENZONE stalked leaders along rail to top stretch, eased, in apparent distress, vanned off.
