Footnotes

AITCHO between horses early, steadied in tight into the first turn, took the lead outside a rival, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again nearing the second turn and held on gamely under urging. COMMANDEERED pulled his way along off the rail then angled in onto foes into the first turn, steadied into the backstretch, stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid outside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but could not get by. THRONE OF POWER three deep and in a bit tight into the first turn, chased outside a rival or between foes, angled in and was in tight again in upper stretch, continued along the rail and just got the show. TEMPLE CITY pulled between horses and clipped heels into the first turn, bid between foes on the backstretch, talked outside a rival on the second turn and weakened some but just lost third. SIR BELL settled off the rail then inside, came out in upper stretch and improved position. GOLD STAR STATUS stalked four wide on the first turn and backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. PREMIUM QUALITY pulled inside then took up off heels and came out into the first turn, angled back in, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. QUARTA COROA (BRZ) stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry, COMMANDEERED was disqualified and placed seventh for interference into the first turn.
